

# WHAT IS IT?

The STRAC Universal ID Card is a credit card-sized smart card. It stores your digital identity and can only be accessed by you.

To access the card you must know the correct PIN (personal identification number) or present the correct fingerprint.



# HOW IS IT USED?

The card has multiple uses including:

- Garage access
- Building access
- Computer access
- Digital signature
- Emergency coordination

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## WHY DOES A PHYSICIAN NEED A UNIVERSAL ID CARD?

The card can be useful to physicians who visit many locations in any given day such as hospitals, their offices, pharmacies, labs, parking garages and secured areas in certain buildings. Many of these access points require an ID card for access.



The STRAC Universal ID Card consolidates all of your separate digital identities onto one card.

## IS IT SECURE?

The technology in the STRAC Universal ID card is the same as that used by banks to secure trillions of dollars in transactions daily.

Similar smart cards are also used by the FBI and CIA to verify identity and security clearance.

## IS THERE A COST?

No, the Universal ID Card is free for all San Antonio area physicians. STRAC and area hospitals are covering the cost of this program as a service to the community.

## HOW DO I GET ONE?

You must be sponsored by a hospital with which you are affiliated. Sponsorship will take place automatically for all physicians.

Once you are sponsored, you will be contacted with further information on where and how to complete the process.

It will take about 10 - 15 minutes and must be done in person. Two forms of identification are required and at least one of these must be a government issued photo ID such as your drivers license. For example you can use your voter's registration card or social security card for your second form of identification.

Your biometrics (fingerprints) will be taken during enrollment to ensure only you can activate and use your card.



## ENROLLMENT LOCATIONS

Once you are notified you've been sponsored by a hospital you can proceed to enrollment.

At that time you may select a location that is most convenient for you, including:

- Baptist Hospitals
- Bexar County Medical Society
- CHRISTUS Santa Rosa Hospitals
- Methodist Hospitals
- Nix Hospital
- Southwest General Hospital
- STRAC Office

## DOES THE CARD HAVE THE SAME CAPABILITIES AS THE OLD?

Yes. The new card will have all the same capabilities and more. It will provide access to the areas as before, such as the parking lot, lounge, and building. New capabilities such as computer access will be available.

## WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY ID CARD?

It will take just a few days to process your card. It will be available for pick-up and activation at your enrollment location.

## WHAT IF MY CARD IS LOST OR STOLEN?

Contact your sponsoring hospital as soon as you notice your card is missing. It will be deactivated and you will be issued a new card.
