ADULT SEPSIS ALERT CRITERIA

Suspected Infection

- AND -

At least **TWO** of the following:

- Altered mentation*
 (*GCS <15, confusion, agitation, or any change from baseline)
- Systolic Blood Pressure ≤ 100 mmHg
- Respiratory Rate ≥ 20
- Heart Rate > 90

- AND -

End Tidal CO2 ≤ 30 mmHg

SEPSIS ALERT CRITERIA

Suspected Infection**

- AND
Altered Mental Status, OR

Poor Perfusion*

- AND
End Tidal CO2 < 30 mmHg

- **All pediatric patients are at risk of sepsis; however, infection should be strongly considered in patients with:
- Indwelling lines
- Need for ventilator or tracheostomy support
- Recent surgery/hospitalization
- History of immunocompromise/unvaccinated
- Cancer
- Sickle cell disease
- Cystic fibrosis
- Congenital heart disease
- Transplanted organ
- Diabetes

+Capillary Refill >3 seconds, mottled skin, cool/clammy skin, weak/thready pulse

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
