Organized Healthcare Arrangement (OHCA)

- Can be implemented in an organized system of health care in which organizations participate in joint activities and participate in formal quality improvement and quality assessment activities.
- Allows participating covered entity organizations to share protected health information on mutual patients when participating in joint programming.
- Includes a participation agreement document, a policies and procedures manual, as well as an OHCA advisory board that meets annually and requires a majority to amend the agreement.
